8. General Purposes Committee Minutes

12. Allotments

Councillor Adams entered the meeting

a) Clerks Report on the Allotments

The Clerk updated members on current issues, vacancies and the present state of the waiting list and other issues, including progress on surfacing the ramped entrance to the Barnfield site and the condition of the main gate at the Barnfield site. The Clerk was requested to find out about the cost of a replacement gate.

b) Allotment Association and Tenants Issues

An allotment holder at Exhibition Road raised the issue of the broken tap at his allotment site and emphasised that the lack of rain over recent weeks coupled with the single tap on the site was having a very detrimental effect upon the tenants crops. A representative of the Allotment Association informed the Committee that he had obtained quotations from some engineering companies that provide suitable push action taps for the allotments. He also reported that the tap on the Barnfield site, nearest to Barnfield, does not work properly.

c) Proposals For Replacement Water Supply Fittings

A proposal by Councillor Adams was received suggesting the broken tap at Exhibition Road not be replaced and instead a small agricultural style trough, such as Exeter City Council use, be installed. One of the allotment tenants and the Allotment Association representative, on behalf of the Association, both strongly opposed this suggestion on the grounds of safety, especially for young families, reliability and the liability of the ball-valves freezing open, thus leading to flooding and also that tenants had already previously stated their preference for taps.

The Committee, therefore, agreed that the broken taps should be replaced, the one in Exhibition Road as the priority. The Allotment Association suggested that they could replace the other taps, although this would take some preparation. As it was understood that informal discussions as to the Association removing all the taps during the winter had taken already taken place, it was agreed to request the Allotment Association formally consider making such a proposal.

13. Planning

- d) Development Management Development Plan Document

The District Councils Development Management Development Plan Document was received for consideration. Also, tabled, a report and proposed responses on the issues and options questionnaire was received from Councillor Brookes-Hocking. On consideration of the report, it was agreed to submit the report from Councillor Brookes-Hocking in full. Members also agreed with her that the language of the District Council's report was "fairly impenetrable". Members also formally thanked Councillor Brookes-Hocking for her efforts on this issue.

14. Finance

- a) The Schedule of Accounts, Cheque numbers 3274 to 3284 totalling £12,089.87, was approved.

- Councillor Hughes declared a personal interest.

A donation of £250- pounds was agreed by the Committee although there was some concern over the status of the organisation and its eligibility for a grant. The donation was therefore conditional on establishing the eligibility of Journey to receive the grant.

The consultation document on proposals to relax the planning rules for change of use from commercial to residential was received and noted. Members felt that this appeared to be a good idea generally, as long as the development was appropriate to the location and that local council planning departments have the final say so that there is some form of local control over unsuitable develop.

The loading bay and parking restrictions on Market Street adjacent to Market Square House were considered and members felt that it was the placing and lack of signage that was causing the problem. <u>It was recommended that the Council write to the County</u> <u>Council to request an additional sign on Market Square House</u> between the Post Office and the new coffee shop.
