AGENDA ITEMS

50. Apologies

Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor Coyngham for personal reasons and from the Crediton Fairtrade Partnership for not being able to attend.

55. General Purposes Committee Minutes

The minutes of the General Purposes Committee meeting held on 5 July 2011 were received and approved as a correct record.

56. Matters Arising

Minute 42: It was noted that the two trees aforementioned had been removed.

Minute 44: The Assistant Clerk was requested to ensure that the Speedwatch scheme volunteers ad been informed.

57. Allotments

a) Clerks Report on the Allotments

The Assistant Clerk updated members on current issues, vacancies and the present state of the waiting list and other issues, including progress on sourcing planeings for the ramped entrance to the Barnfield site and the completion of the installation of the new gate there.

b) Allotment Association and Tenants Issues

A representative of the Allotment Association reported that tenants at Barnfield were getting fed up with the unserviceable tap nearest to the main gate at Barnfield. It was pointed out that there was an agenda item concerning upgrading the taps, including repairing that particular tap.

- c) The Allotment Annual Rental Documentation
 - Copies of the documentation for tenants, including the tenancy agreement and the Allotment Association newsletter were tabled and approved and the committee approved the 2011 2012 rental fee at 15 pence per square meter per annum.
- d) Proposals For Replacement Taps on the Allotments
 - A quotation was tabled for the necessary work to install a control valve in each stand pipe to enable the allotment taps to be removed each winter to prevent damage. Members agreed that the work should be carried out and that the Allotment Association be approached to shut off the water and remove the taps in the Autumn for over-winter storage.
- e) Proposed Lay-Aside Areas for Exhibition Road.

A quotation was tabled for the necessary materials to install manure lay-aside areas inside the main gates at the Exhibition Road site. Committee members agreed that the Council would purchase the materials for an allotment tenant to build them.

A series of e-mail exchanges between Councillor Leighton Plom and the Police Authority were received and noted. Councillor Leighton Plom reported that the authority's responses had satisfied him as to the operation of the new public contact arrangements.

64. Remembrance Services Road Closures

The implications of the Remembrance Day road closures meeting between the Town Clerk, County Council Officers and the President of the Crediton Branch of the Royal British Legion, of 1 September 2011 were reported to members. It was noted that the County Council would not charge a fee for processing road closure traffic orders.

65. Broadband Survey

The request of the constituency Member for Parliament for the Council to conduct a survey of broadband speeds in the area was received and members agreed that the Council will administer the survey. It was also agreed that the survey should be as wide ranging as possible and should involve the Chamber of Commerce. Members requested that the Town Clerk publicize the survey as necessary and also to advise all Councillors how they could monitor their broadband speeds.

Business Brought Forward

72. Moto Xross Noise Complaints

The Council Chairman reported that he had received a number of telephone complaints concerning the noise from the Moto Xross event held over the weekend to the west of the town, on the Yeoford road.

73. Parliament Street Development Site Cleanliness

The Council Chairman reported on the mud on the road in Parliament Street outside the new development alongside the telephone exchange. The Clerk was requested to inform the Highway Authority to monitor the situation.

74. High Street Loading Bays

Councillor Dixon reported that the removal of the roadway "loading bay" markings on the High Street was causing much confusion and he believed resulted in increased parking ticketing. It was noted that the Department for Transport advice on the issue was for guidance only and was not mandatory. The Clerk was requested to contact the Highway Authority to re-emphasise the Town Council's position on loading bay markings and to reinstate the road markings.

75. High Street Traffic Flow

Councillor Connell reported that the changes to parking bays and road markings at the bus stops in the centre of the High Street had resulted in greater traffic congestion, not less. It was noted that the original proposal for an offset centre line would have allowed traffic to pass the stopped buses and that without it drivers were not taking the initiative to pull out around the buses. The Clerk was requested to contact the Highways Authority to re-emphasise the Council's position on the offset centreline. It was agreed that Councillor Hughes of the County Council be copied in.

76. Market Street Loading Bays

Councillor Connell requested an update on his suggestion for improving signage for the Market Street Loading Bays. The Clerk updated members on current progress.

77. Crediton Volunteer Group

Councillor Hughes reported attending the recent meeting of the Crediton Volunteer Group. It was reported that Involve Mid Devon were asking for any suggestions for local volunteer organisations to be listed in a local directory.

78. DALC General Purposes Committee

Councillor Hughes reported that she will be attending the forthcoming DALC General Purposes Committee meeting.

79. Sustainable Crediton Proposed Climate Change Seminar

The Clerk reminded members that Councillors had agreed to consider the submitted papers from Sustainable Crediton with a view to inviting them to organise a seminar for the Council on climate change and the challenges it poses for Crediton. This was requested as a future agenda item.
