## **D-Day 80** THURSDAY, 6 JUNE

6 June 2024 marks 80 years since the D-Day landings, the largest seaborne invasion in history. To commemorate D-Day 80 and other battles of 1944, the town crier will read a proclamation on the Town Square at 8am. In the evening, a beacon lighting ceremony will take place in Beacon Park (at the top of George Hill). All welcome there from 8pm onwards to enjoy music from the Town Band and refreshments as well as a selection of classic cars. The beacon will be lit at 9.15 pm. They continue the good work of garden designer Kendra Ezekiel and other volunteers to create a garden attractive to insects and other animal wildlife, as well as being pleasing and colourful for visitors. To keep a wildlife garden 'wild' is a lot of work! But very rewarding. In March, a selection of shrubs funded by the town council were planted to improve year-round structure. This June the plan is to construct more rockery features and planting mounds.


