
Cllr Wyer returned to the room.

We are covered by the Financial Services Compensation Scheme (FSCS). The FSCS can pay compensation to depositors if a bank is unable to meet its financial obligations. Most depositors – including most individuals and small businesses – are covered by the scheme.

An eligible depositor is entitled to claim compensation up to the maximum level of cover provided by the FSCS. For joint accounts each account holder is treated as having a claim in respect of their share so, for a joint account held by two eligible depositors, the maximum amount that could be claimed would be twice the level of cover. The compensation limit relates to the **combined** amount in all the eligible depositor's accounts with a bank, including their share of any joint account, and not to each separate account.

# **Community Briefing Note**

# **Concerns regarding odour from Crediton Dairy**

# 29 August 2019

This briefing note is issued by the Environment Agency in response to reports of odour from Crediton Dairy.

Crediton Dairy Limited hold an Environmental Permit which authorises the treating and processing of milk and the treatment of effluent at the site. The Environment Agency is responsible for assessing compliance with the Environmental Permit to ensure that the environment and local communities are protected.

Officers from the Environment Agency have visited Crediton and have identified odours offsite which are attributable to Crediton Dairy. The effluent treatment plant has been found to be one of the sources of the odour and Crediton Dairy Limited are investigating the reason for this.

Unfortunately we cannot provide feedback to all reports made. However when you call us, your report is formally logged and an anonymous copy of the report is passed to Crediton Dairy for them to act on.

Please continue to report any incidents of odour pollution to us. You can do this by calling our 24 hour Environmental Incident Hotline telephone number on 0800 80 70 60.

You can also contact the site directly to convey your concerns.
