Crediton Town Council has recently published the Crediton Community Emergency Plan. The aim of the Plan is to provide Crediton with an outline to support itself when other agencies are overstretched and to increase the resilience of the Town. This has been devised by the Emergency Plan's Community Response Team (CRT), made up of members of the community with local knowledge.

The plan includes a list of 'vulnerable people' within the Town. The aim of this list is to ensure the CRT are aware of who may need extra help or support during any kind of emergency.


