Between the hours of **08:00** and **19:00**

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed or wait, load or unload on the sections of Affected Roads.

MARKET STREET, PARLIAMENT STREET, CREDITON

The alternative, signed, route for vehicles will be via - HIGH STREET, UNION ROAD, EAST STREET, MILL STREET, BLAGDON TERRACE, JOCKEY HILL, HIGHER ROAD, ALEXANDRA ROAD, PEOPLES PARK ROAD, DEEP LANE, PARLIAMENT STREET

Nothing within this Temporary Traffic Regulation Order shall apply to authorised vehicles being used for the Crediton Food Festival event.
