There will be entertainment on the High Street between 4.00 pm to 5.00 pm and it is hoped this will include Great Western Morris, Amy Charles Academy of Dance, Town Crier and circus acts.

Outline plan/ideas for Switch On -26th November 2016

Rosemary and Peter met to discuss and wonder about this year's event out of which emerged:

Minutes item 56 Music/Entertainment in the square 2.00pm onwards

We discussed some of the implications for this and wondered:

More infrastructure would be needed in terms of planning, volunteers, entertainment A successful event with a vibrant atmosphere etc could be in competition with what is planned for the High Street and spread an audience too thinly

An event in the square would need stalls, food and drink outlets which could impact on the empty space needed later

We'd be planning to staff the Square from 2.00pm to 8.30/9.00pm

As a result we wondered about the wisdom, logistics, organising, staffing planning etc of entertainment n the Square on Saturday afternoon

Theme; having wondered and discussed possible themes 'Outer Space' arrived. This could inspire, drive some thinking and excitement

- Young people dressing up --stars and planets, spaceships, astronauts, aliens, Star Wars characters, Martians etc
- Large illuminated lanterns, made by groups (scouts, guides, primary schools, youth groups etc) to represent: planets, stars, spaceships, telescopes etc, (note five 2D stars from the first switch on are already waiting in the garage!)
