 could be in Italics or a different colour to make it more obvious to users.
- 38. To discuss progress regarding cycle route provision (Agenda item requested by Cllr Fawssett)

 The Administrative Officer advised that due to Cllr Brookes-Hocking not being present it was difficult to discuss this item in great depth. A meeting of the A377 action group with DCC and WPS has been requested regarding the the cycle link between Exeter and Crediton. They are persuing the quiet lanes approach which is not deemed acceptable. Cllr Fawssett commented that he had spoken with various groups, one being Boniface Trail Association who have suggested a route via fields. He commented that the route must be suitable before approaching DCC again. Cllr Cochran commented that this will be an ongoing issue as DCC don't have the



funds for this project. It was agreed for Cllr Fawssett and Cllr Brookes-Hocking to continue communication with groups on behalf of the Town Council.
