122. Apologies

124. Public Question Time

A member of the public from Downeshead Lane raised local and personal concerns over the link road variation. The County ward member had provided copies of the concept plans for information and would be happy to provide an explanation for councillors and members of the public. It was agreed that agenda items 9 and 13 would be advanced to accommodate members of the public.

125. Chairman's & Clerk's Announcements and Meeting Management None.

126. General Purposes Committee Minutes

The minutes of the General Purposes Committee meeting held on 12 December 2008 were received and approved as a correct record.

127. Floral Crediton Working Group Meeting Notes

Not available, deferred to next meeting. The next Floral Crediton Working Group meeting had been rearranged for 18 March.

128. Police Liaison Meeting Notes The notes of the Police Liaison meeting held on 16 February 2009 were received and noted.

129. Allotments

a) Allotment Update

The Clerk reported that there had been one tenancy change and the waiting list remained extensive.

b) Matters Raised By Tenants

A request had been received to plant fruit trees at a Barnfield allotment (B9AA). The tenant had agreed to comply with the conditions contained in the tenancy agreement. Permission was granted.

130. Highways Issues

a) Variation to Link Road

The County ward member provided an update and presented detailed drawings of the provisional proposals. The variation had been suggested largely on the grounds of costs which would be much less as a result of the reduction in earth movements. English Heritage had also raised concerns over protected land. Further investigations and a full audit would be carried out before the proposed public exhibition and the submission of a planning application. It was hoped that the public exhibition would take place in the late summer or early autumn (avoiding August).

Members suggested that there was a clear need to see details of the specific changes and improvements before the exhibition. Members also hoped that some information would be made available for the Annual Town Meeting scheduled for 28 April.

Concerns were expressed over the proposed location of the junction with Commonmarsh Lane. It was suggested that the link road be realigned to join Commonmarsh Lane at a location beyond the present scrap yard; this would allow for an extension to the proposed 4.5m bund which should substantially attenuate potential traffic noise.

b) Road Closure Notices

Parliament Street

Noted and acknowledged that the work needed to be done and was long overdue. *Exeter Road*

There were no objections on condition that the works were properly regulated and that any traffic controls were manually controlled at peak times.

131. Planning

a) Planning Decisions

Noted. Decisions notified by the planning authority are appended.

b) Planning Applications

Comments made in respect of planning applications considered at this meeting are appended.

The Chairman declared a prejudicial interest in application 00244/MOUT and left the meeting for the duration of the debate on this item. The Vice Chairman took the chair for this item only.

c) Planning Applications/Items for Determination week ending 3 March 2009 No additional applications had been received from the Planning Authority.

Crediton Hamlets Parish Council Noticeboard

Crediton Hamlets Parish Council had requested permission to use a small section of land within the town boundary for the erection of a parish noticeboard. The Parish Council was happy to allow the Town Council use of the noticeboard for any information of value to local residents.

Members were happy to allow Crediton Hamlets to erect a noticeboard at Westernlea.

Network Rail Communications Masts

The Clerk had circulated details on the consultation event organised for elected members on 20 March. Councillors Finnegan, Nation, Downes and Way agreed to attend and would report to the next meeting.

d) Planning Seminar

Members expressed disappointment that many people were unable to attend the seminar due to the adverse weather conditions and it was hoped that a similar event could be organised for later in the year. MDDC and DCC ward members agreed to ask their respective councils if the seminar could be repeated with invitations being sent to local parish councils.

132. Peoples Park and Scout Memorial Gardens

a) Crediton Tree Group

The Tree Group had suggested the planting of a memorial tree at Peoples Park to commemorate 1100th Anniversary and Festival 2009.

Members agreed that the proposals were interesting and that the Council would be consulting on its plan (including Peoples Park) at the Annual Town Meeting on 28 April. The views and assistance of the group would be greatly appreciated.

b) Update

The Clerk reported that he had completed applications for the DCC Locality Budget and Local Project Funds. He also suggested that the Council should give serious consideration to applying for a grant under the Parks for People scheme, recently announced by the Heritage Lottery Fund.

Agenda item next Council meeting.

Councillor Nation left the meeting.

133. Parish Paths Partnership

a) Update

The Clerk updated members on the current situation and financial status of the P3 Scheme.

Due to staff shortages, he had been unable to organise a P3 budget meeting for 2009/2010 and as a consequence there was a risk of a reduction in the DCC grant. However, DCC had agreed to provide funding to a similar level if the Council agreed to assist with the repair/reinstatement of footpath 24 which was in a poor condition. FP24 was one of the most frequently used parish footpaths. The Town Council would be expected to provide up to £500 funding, the majority of the cost would be recouped when the 2009/2010 grant was received in April.

b) Action

Members supported the initiative and agreed that the footpath was in great need of repair.

134. CCTV

No progress had been made since the previous meeting.

135. Council Meeting Dates and Annual Town Meeting

- a) Members adjusted meeting dates to accommodate the inclusion of additional meetings. The Clerk to re-circulate for final confirmation at next meeting.
- b) It was recommended that the date for the Annual Town Meeting be changed to 28 April to allow time for preparation of items and material for a pre-meeting exhibition. It was also suggested that the venue be changed to the Congregational Church, if possible. The Clerk to arrange.

Councillor Wright left the meeting.

136. Council Newsletters

It was acknowledged that a minimum of four newsletters would be required for gaining Quality Council status. It was recommended that the Council continued with the current number of editions and copies in order to remain within the budget set by the Council at its January meeting.

The Communications Working Group to look at the future development of the newsletters and how the local press could be used to better effect in promoting the Council and its achievements.

137. Highways Issues

The Clerk had circulated the request from the Crediton & District Access Group for improvements in Mill Street, Church Lane and the Town Square.

It was generally accepted that improvements were needed in Mill Street and that the Council had previously requested action from both principal authorities. The County ward member confirmed that the Highway Authority was aware of the problems and, as soon as a planning opportunity arose, appropriate action would be taken. The County ward member agreed to raise the matter at a forthcoming meeting with the highway's engineer including the possibility of providing an additional pedestrian crossing.

It was reported that the issues relating to the Town Square were due to be rectified within the next few weeks.

The suggestion for a pedestrian route through the Milk Link site was considered interesting and it was suggested that the planners investigate the possibility of using the lane adjacent to East Street, if a suitable opportunity arose.

138. Bus Services

Concerns were expressed over the traffic delays caused by buses at St Lawrence Green, particularly the 1535 service. It was recommended that a letter be sent to Stagecoach Busses and DCC. Councillor Finnegan agreed to draft a letter for the Clerk setting out the problems.
