The information provided by Mid Devon District Council was discussed. It was **resolved** to write to the bus and coach companies who have objected to the closure of St Lawrence Green toilets requesting a significant financial contribution to enable the Town Council to keep the toilets open, explaining that if no financial contributions are forthcoming from the companies the toilets will close. (Proposed by Cllr Letch, seconded by Cllr Brookes-Hocking)

It was also **resolved** that should Mid Devon District Council withdraw the partnership payments, the Town Council will not make a contribution to keep the Town Hall toilets open to the public. (Proposed by Cllr Brookes-Hocking, seconded by Cllr Ford)

It was further **resolved** that should Mid Devon District Council decide that Newcombes Meadow toilets will only open during British Summer Time, the Town Council will consider making some funding available to ensure the toilets remain open all year round. (Proposed by Cllr Brookes-Hocking, seconded by Cllr Letch)

39 To approve the Mayor's attendance at liberation celebrations in Avranches on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2014 and agree the budget.

Cllr Letch declared an interest. It was **resolved** to approve the Mayor's attendance at liberation celebrations in Avranches on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2014 and for the travel expenses incurred to be met from the hospitality budget. (Proposed by Cllr Brookes-Hocking, seconded by Cllr Harris)

# 40 Business brought forward

- Cllr Adams asked if members had experienced issues with the new Belle Parade cycle route, as he had witnessed a cyclist proceeding up Belle Parade into oncoming traffic. The Clerk advised that the new Belle Parade cycle route was experiencing teething troubles, however, Devon County Council had confirmed there are still works to be completed on the scheme, following this it would undergo a safety audit. She asked Councillors to e-mail her with details of any complaints/comments they receive regarding the scheme, including any reports of cyclists continuing to cycle up Belle Parade into oncoming traffic. Cllr Adams suggested a sign was needed outside Crediton Library warning motorists of oncoming cyclists.
- Cllr Brookes-Hocking provided an update on the REALDevon Local Action Group meeting held on Monday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014. Devon County Council is working with Mid Devon District Council to develop a bid for a new Local Action Group (LAG), primarily covering Mid Devon parishes. The LAGs are currently working on bids to be submitted to DEFRA in early September for funding allocations to distribute from Jan 2015-2020. One of the suggestions from the participants on Monday had been to map the resources in our area such as the potential attractions that would bring people in, e.g. food producers. The funding has a strong focus on increasing employment and tourism.
- Town Clerk advised that Bonheur have not closed, they are moving on to the High Street and that it is still unknown who is taking the old Costcutter building, Haarer Goss, will not divulge the information.
