It was resolved to note the budget sheet and the information contained therein. (Proposed by Cllr Letch)
- To receive a report from the Council's internal control checkers, following the monthly random inspection and agree any actions. Copies of the reports had been issued with the agenda. It was resolved to note the report with no further actions. (Proposed by Cllr Letch)
- To consider and agree/amend Crediton Town Council's budgets prepared by the Council's Responsible Financial Officer for the financial year 2018-2019. Copies of the draft budget had been issued with the agenda. Members discussed the increase in the budget and Cllr Letch read the proposed press statement explaining the increase in the precept. It was resolved to agree the Town Council's budgets for the financial year 2018-2019, with a total budgeted expenditure of £269,623 and a total budgeted income of £30,159 (£28,203 Council income and £1,956 MDDC DCLG Grant) excluding precept, a copy of which is attached to these minutes as Appendix Four. (Proposed by Cllr Brookes-Hocking. Cllrs Wright & Szabo requested for the minutes to show they voted against.)

Cllr Wright:

New "any bin will do" stickers are being printed for the town litter bins. These will soon be going on all the litter bins in the Town except those located within play areas.

 MDDC's draft budget report includes an extra £10,000 for toilet maintenance and upkeep.

### Cllr Szabo:

Attended a site visit on Tinpot Lane, with other members of the Parish Paths
Committee and it was a thoroughly enjoyable route. It was agreed that
Community Pay Back may be able to help in pushing the leaves off to the sides
to reduce the slip hazard.

### Cllr Ross:

 Attended the Crediton Hospital League of Friends meeting, however the group did not seem to be expecting Councillors to attend so they left.

### Cllr Piercy:

Will be attending a new councillor training course tomorrow.

### Cllr Downes:

• Had attended the recent MDDC Planning Committee meeting where the Cromwells Meadow application had been considered. Cllr Downes was concerned that MDDC's new Head of Planning gave a bias steer at the meeting and has concerns about how the application was being judged and whether it was being considered against the existing Local Plan or the emergent plan. Councillors agreed it would be beneficial to invite the new Head of Planning to a Council meeting.

### Cllr Way:

Attended a meeting with Cllr Brookes-Hocking and members of Devon County Council regarding the upcoming A377 road closure. Cllr Way advised members that he has a copy of the map showing the closure and diversion. The closure will start on 15<sup>th</sup> January 2018 for up to one month. The works are necessary as the road is collapsing. The diversion uses A & B roads, however some local roads will be made one way to try and reduce congestion. School buses and public buses have been made aware of the road closure.

### Cllr Zorlu:

- Has received lots of good reports from the Christmas Lights Switch-on and passed on big praise to the committee.
- Is pleased to see so many petitions for the retention of the Council Office building and the services within it.

### Cllr Brookes-Hocking:

 Attended a meeting with the Town Clerk and Cllr Letch to provide Dawn Eckhart, from Devon Communities Together, with an update on the Council Office building, following her work on the feasibility study as well as obtaining advice from Dawn.

The Assistant Clerk advised members that Cllr Hughes has been invited to join a research team at the Children's Centre looking into baby brain development, under a programme called Thrive.

### 1712/226 Business brought forward

### Cllr Szabo:

- The Railway Tea Rooms are closing after 18 years of running. Linda Brown will be leaving and the building will be managed by an outside management company. There is currently a lot of railway memorabilia, mainly posters, in the Tea Rooms and these belong to Linda. Linda has expressed an interest in selling these and Cllr Szabo wanted to put forward the idea of the Council purchasing them. Members were interested in purchasing the memorabilia and agreed for it to be included on the next agenda. In the meantime, the Council staff will obtain further information including how many posters there are, pictures of the posters, and the prices.
- Took the Council Building petition to residents on his street and got 60 signatures. A petition was also given to Crediton Hospital and, in less than one day, the petition had 15 signatures with 1/3 belonging to people outside of Crediton.

### Cllr Piercy:

The Bigger Picture Gallery will be holding an exhibition in March 2018 called "We Are Crediton". This will include photos of residents of Crediton, so she will be walking around the Town taking photos over the next couple of months. Cllr Downes advised that Peter Hamilton did something similar in 2000 so she may want to contact him.

### Cllr Downes:

 South West Galvanisers have installed very powerful floodlights on their site and they are not shielded. This is contributing to light pollution within the town and Cllr Downes has referred the issue to MDDC. It was agreed for the Town Council to write to MDDC to reinforce the issue.

### Cllr Way:

 Advised that empty grit bins need to be reported as DCC will not fill them unless they receive a specific request.

The Assistant Clerk advised members that Cllr Hughes has requested for the Town Council to have a tree at next year's Christmas Tree Festival. It was agreed for this to be considered by the Christmas in Crediton Committee.
