Cllr Letch reminded members that a proportion of the budget needs to be held back for applications that may be submitted throughout the financial year.

Due to the large amount of grant applications received this year, with the total being £27,494.71, members agreed that a strategy was needed as to how to assess the applications. Each application was considered on how it fits within the Council's Strategic Action Plan, the budget available and the level of funding requested.
