It was resolved that £32,600 allocated to organisations/groups at the meeting held on 29 November 2022 would remain the same, as the recently set budget of £33,000 agreed by Full Council, would be sufficient to cover it. The remaining £400 would be held for any future successful 2023-24 applications. (Proposed by Cllr Brookes-Hocking)
- 23. To consider a virement of £3,316.48 to ear marked reserves due to underspend in the financial year 2022/23, for approval by Full Council. Further information had been issued with the agenda. It was resolved to move the £3,316.48 of remaining money from the 2022-23 budget to the 2023-24 budget, leaving a total of £3,716.48 remaining for the financial year 2023-24. 24. To consider amending the grant application process for 2024/25 and beyond.

A copy of report had been issued before the meeting.
