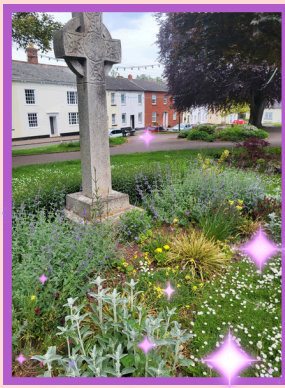
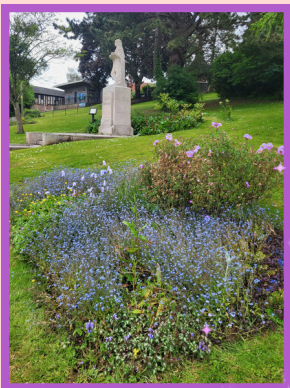

EMERGENCY PLANNING



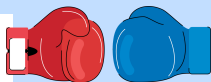

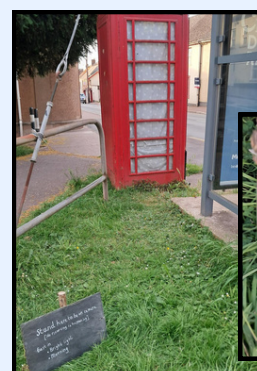
CHECK THIS OUT!

ENVIRONMENTAL UPDATE

from Cllr Backhouse



The Town Council continues to support local environmental action and community conversation. In June, Sustainable CREDITON in conjunction with the Town Council hosted a well-attended screening of National Emergency Briefing (NEB), a 50-minute documentary exploring the growing impacts of climate change in the UK and calling for clear national communication on climate risks. Although Mel Stride MP, invited by the Town Council, was unable to attend on the 10 June, he has now been invited to a future screening later this summer at a date that fits his commitments, to encourage open discussion with residents.

Our volunteer-led CREDITON Urban Taskforce [CUT!] meets every 2nd Saturday of the month 10 am - 12 noon. On 13 June, 11 volunteers contributed over 20 hours to weed the Town Square with hand tools, leaving it tidy, and preserving some pollinator species.

It's encouraging to see residents taking similar action across town, including Independents for CREDITON's annual Weed 'n' Sweep of the High Street, and other residents tackling Blagdon Road.

We are also taking practical steps within the town. Although some councils continue using glyphosate, we are prohibiting or limiting its use wherever possible. We are working with local retailers to encourage them to reduce prominent displays of glyphosate products in foyers and window fronts. Homeleigh Garden Centre does not do this, however we are still awaiting Tesco to change its head office-based planning for spring foyer displays.

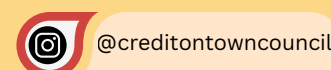
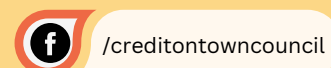
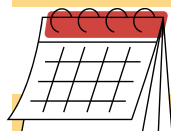


2025-26 ANNUAL REPORT AVAILABLE SOON
