#### Get to know the Guest Speaker



Dr David Jenner is currently a GP at College Surgery in Cullompton. As a founder member of the Mid Devon Doctors' Commissioning Group in 1993, Dr Jenner chaired the group through its evolution from Locality Commissioning Group, through GP commissioning pilot in 1998, to Primary Care Group (PCG) in 1999. In addition, he was Mid Devon PCG chairman from 1999-2001 and then Professional Executive Committee Chair of the Mid-Devon Primary Care Trust until September 2003.

Most recently, Dr Jenner was the Eastern Locality Chair and Board Member of NEW Devon CCG. With his wealth of knowledge and experience within the NHS, we are confident Dr Jenner will provide you with a clearer understanding of current policy and how it will affect our community.

#### **Annual Town Meeting**

This year's Annual Town Meeting, held at the Boniface Centre, was extremely well attended. Twenty reports were received from a wide range of community groups and organisations all of which are making a positive impact in our community through a diverse range of activities. It is always astounding just how much happens in our wonderful town.

#### **Making a Difference**

This year the Town Council received a record number of grant funding applications, which resulted in it increasing the 2018-2019 grants budget by a further £5,000 to £25,000. The list to the right shows all of the grant cheques that will be presented at this year's Mayor's Reception.

#### **Play Area Update**

Since taking on the three new play areas at Spinning Path Gardens, Fulda Crescent and Greenway, the Town Council has taken its new areas of responsibility seriously and, after a successful public consultation, has been making some positive improvements.

This has included new signage at all three sites, a new fence and the clearing of overgrowth at Fulda Crescent as well as the installation of a bin at Spinning Path Gardens.



This is on top of implementing a regular maintenance schedule. Following the feedback received on Greenway play area and residents' concern regarding its inappropriate use, the Town Council has decided to hand the area back to the District Council. This will take effect from 8th June 2018.

#### Britain In Bloom (BIB)


The town will once again be entering the prestigious BIB competition this summer in the Pennant category, along with 14 entries into the It's Your Neighbourhood competition.
