

WHAT IS [CUT!] ALL ABOUT?



Crediton Urban Taskforce [CUT!] are still working hard to remove weeds, clear/sweep pavements, and improve the overall look of our town. In recent months, [CUT!] have also started to clean road signs that are in need of some TLC. These actions are entirely down to wonderful and willing volunteers that we are very lucky to have.

Crediton Town Council is supporting the amazing work of [CUT!] with a budget of £1,500 for 2024-25 to cover tools, printing, refreshments etc.

Isn't this why we pay our Council Tax?

We understand these frustrations. Despite Devon County Council and Mid Devon District Council once carrying out services like this, budget cuts mean that they are no longer in a position to continue to do so and with services such as weeding being “non-statutory services” this inevitably leads to them being withdrawn.

Crediton Town Council could take on services such as weeding across the town, however this would require an increase in the precept to allow for the extra costs involved. Decisions such as these will be discussed at this year's budgeting workshops, open to all members of the public, so look out for the dates and please do come along to share your views!

In the meantime, the [CUT!] schedule continues, with action days taking place on the 2nd Saturday of every month from 10.00 - 12.00. If you would like to get involved please visit the [CUT!] webpage for details on how to join.

A MULTI-USE PATH FROM CREDITON TO EXETER?




Many of you will be aware of the desire for a safe cycle/pedestrian path from Crediton to Exeter, one that doesn't use existing highway (A377 or otherwise), to serve as a safe and environmentally-friendly way of accessing Crediton, Exeter and everywhere in between!

The A377 Action Group and Boniface Trail Association have worked hard since 2016 to bring this idea to the forefront of Devon County Council's priorities, and we have now formed a group to work with DCC and their consultants to bring forward proposals for a route. Crediton Town Council, Newton St Cyres Parish Council, Crediton Hamlets Parish Council, along with higher council authorities and interested community groups have met with DCC to understand the proposed route, to provide initial feedback and have pledged to work with the community and DCC to move the project forward.

Consultations for both this project and DCC's new Local Cycling and Walking Infrastructure Plan (LCWIP) are due to start in the autumn and we will ensure that these are shared as widely as possible. Please keep an eye out for updates on our website, social media and future newsletters.
