**46 To receive and accept apologies**

**49 To note that decisions will be made with the climate emergency at the forefront of decision and policy making**

**51 Chairman's and Clerk's Announcements**

**52 Committee Meeting Minutes - To approve and sign as a correct record the minutes of the Assets & Amenities Committee meeting held on 23 November 2021**

It was **resolved** to approve the minutes. (Proposed by Cllr Zorlu).

**53 Allotments:**

- **To consider the following issues and agree a course of action – vacant plots, Non-Cultivation Notices and Notices to Quit**

It was noted that there are no vacant plots, non-cultivation notices and no notice to quits.

- **To receive an update on water troughs at Barnfield**

It had not been possible to obtain any further quotes. It was **agreed** that the cost was high

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and may have to be considered in a future budget.

- **To consider matters raised by the Boniface Allotments Association and allotment tenants and agree any actions**

**54 To receive an update on concerns regarding street lighting at Threshers**

The Town Clerk had circulated an email from Devon County Council, which was noted. The contents explained that there was no budget available for additional lighting, but that the Town Council could purchase a new streetlight which could potentially be adopted. The Town Clerk had responded with further questions and a response is awaited.

**55 To consider and approve the quote for litter bin painting in the High Street**

It was requested that Turning Tides be contacted regarding the painting of the litter bins, with the Town Council supplying the paint.

**56 To discuss point B of the outline management recommendations on page 3 of the recent QTRA report and agree a course of action**

It was noted that Cllrs Szabo and Cochran would meet at Peoples Park to assess the trees and report to the next meeting.

**57 To receive an update on the crescent shaped rose bed behind the Boniface statue and agree a course of action**

It was **noted** that there was no update.

**58 Tree planting and open spaces:**

- **To agree wording for the plaque at the trees at Peoples Park in recognition of the NHS and Covid-19 pandemic**

It was **resolved** to approve the following wording: 'Dedicated to all Kirtonians affected by the Covid-19 pandemic. Thank you to our local NHS workers'. (Proposed by Cllr Zorlu).
